ORGANIZATIONAL INFORMATION

BANGON CADIZNON INTRODUCTION and HISTORICAL SUMMARY

BANGON CADIZNON is a Non-Government Organization which was founded for the benefit of the Cadiznons during the Calamity of Typhoon Haiyan & Yolanda. It was formed with its humble beginnings of having only two boxes of sardines and two boxes of noodles given by one good friend of our Co-Founder Joemarie Echavez. The Co-Founder discussed his dilemma of lacking rice to add to the given goods for distribution. He approached Mr. Chris Montañó who later founded BANGON CADIZNON. Chris and Joemarie are good friends and have the heart to always help their fellow Cadiznons.

Chris is a Marketing and Branding specialist by profession, and begun his career as an Internet Specialist. During the start of the Typhoon, Chris already created a Website at www.cadiz-city.com which is functioning for the last 10 years to provide the needed information to Cadiznons as a private news site.

During this time, Chris' website was the only website updating the Cadiznons as to the current status of the Typhoon and when there was no power, mobile phone connection and internet connection; due to his creative means he has still continued to update the Cadiznons abroad about the current situation of Cadiz. Using his methods of having an internet connection and power, he managed to stay online for the next days after the Typhoon to campaign for Help for Cadiz.

During this time, families from abroad are frantic in finding news about their loved ones in Cadiz, and at this time, Chris' website received almost 500plus inquiries and calls for help asking OFW families to locate their loved ones, even foreigners who have found a home in Cadiz also used the site and it's corresponding Social Media pages to ask about their families. Chris mobilized his group and from his own pocket provided gasoline to his friends to enable them to travel and check the families of those who requested help on his site. He answered all the inquiries and thought his "calling" is done.

During this time, as a Barangay Youth Leader, Joemarie Echavez was also busy in providing the help needed on his barangay. Concentrating on the evacuation, rescue and providing comfort to his constituents. At this time, the Sardines and Noodles goods are given to him and that is when Joemarie approached Chris.

Chris started to campaign for Help Online, hoping to add to the 2 Boxes of Sardines and Noodles. Sending several e-mails with news articles from his site to Groups like Sagip Kapamilya, GK and other help organizations, although these groups responded to the call, they all coordinated with the Government and the DSWD.

At this time, Chris received several interested parties, groups, companies and individuals here and abroad who want to help Cadiz and answer Chris' call for help for Cadiz. But the caveat is that they do not want to channel their help through the Government agencies and want it delivered directly to the people. They requested if there was any local group able to do this for them. This is where Chris started and named the Special Operations Group called BANGON CADIZNON which is now evolving into an organization.

BANGON CADIZNONs call for help and marketing resulted in respondents, donors and supporters who at the time of this writing allowed the organization to reach more than 5000 Families in Cadiz City (as well as other Cities and Islands) with Relief Goods containing an assortment of High-Quality items.

BANGON CADIZNON stood by Chris' Mantra for his Team of *"In Everything We Do, It is All for the Greater Glory of God"*

This mantra served as the Mission Statement of BANGON CADIZNON and has influenced the rest of the co-founders of the group to respond for one goal. Helping Cadiz, Helping Cadiznons!

We are aware of the needs of Cadiznons and thus working with other organizations, supporters, Donors and Volunteers; we have saturated and reached those that critically need help.

During this time, a need for a structure of Highly Experienced and Professional individuals was needed to formalize the organization. Chris called on his closest of friends to complete the Core Structure of BANGON CADIZNON since the output of the group surpassed the initial target of only 600 Families. Through Chris' previous affiliation with Gawad Kalinga Cadiz Chapter, the same sets of people were activated for his call to form the BANGON CADIZNON organization.

Since BANGON CADIZNON have finished with the call for help of Relief for those affected by the Typhoon, we now have moved our advocacy to a project presented to us which is **Project: iCARE for DAY CARE**. This project specifically this time targets to benefit the Children of Cadiz. We have already reached around 1000 Children in Cadiz responding to calls of Tables and Chairs, Rehabilitation of Day Cares, Wheelchairs, Gifts, Feeding, School Supplies, Toys and Clothing to the Children of Cadiz.
